The Monroe County Planning Board will hold one information meeting on the County's proposed Capital Improvement Program for 2016-2021:

The agenda for the meeting will be:

1. Opening remarks
2. Presentation of the Proposed County Capital Improvement Program
3. Questions, comments and discussion
4. Closing remarks

There are three major purposes for holding this information meeting:

- (1) To give local government officials and interested citizens an opportunity to know what capital projects the County proposes to build over the next six years (e.g. replace bridges and upgrade traffic signs on County roads; renovate science labs at MCC; refurbish airport passenger loading bridges; improve energy efficiency at waste water treatment plants; upgrade County parks; renovate Zoo entrance and main building; maintain water distribution system; update 911 system).
- (2) To get reactions and comments as to how the projects relate to community and neighborhood plans, programs, and priorities.
- (3) To learn of additional needs that are not addressed by the proposed CIP.

Comments received at the information meeting will be taken into account by the Planning Board in formulating its written recommendations to the County Executive and the County Legislature on the projects contained in the proposed six-year CIP and their priority. The Monroe County Planning Board is charged under Sections C5-7 and C5-8 of the Monroe County Charter with the responsibility for reviewing the County Capital Improvement Program.

The Monroe County Planning Board recognizes that the Capital Program is a lengthy and complex document and that its presentation at one information meeting may not provide you with the opportunity or time to respond as fully as you might wish. The Board wishes to receive comments by March 12, 2015, in order to take them into account in preparing their final recommendations to the County Executive and the County Legislature.
