From the East to Rochester

- Take I-90 West to Rochester Exit 46
- Take 390 North to West Henrietta Road (Route 15)
- Turn right onto West Henrietta Road/Mt. Hope Avenue
- Turn right onto Westfall Road at next light
- 111 Westfall Road is the next 2 entrances
- Free parking is available

From the West to Rochester

- Take 390 South to Exit 16A West Henrietta Road/Route 15
- At Light, veer left onto East River Road
- Turn left at next light onto West Henrietta Road/Mount Hope Avenue
- At 1st light, turn right onto Westfall Road
- 111 Westfall Road is the next 2 entrances
- Free parking is available

The Requirements

As per subpart 14.1 Section 14-1.73 of the NYS Sanitary Code, MCDPH has established the following requirements.

A Certified Food Worker is required to be present at all operating times for food service establishments, including temporary food stands. Operating times are defined as any time when food preparation is being performed and is not limited to the establishment's operating hours.

There are two levels of training. Level 1 Food Manager and Level 2 Food Worker.

All medium and high risk facilities, as well as operators of more than one pushcart need to have a person on record with L1 Certification. The person on record can not be designated for multiple establishments. The presence of a L1 Worker can also satisfy the requirement for a L2 Worker.

Low risk facilities such as bars or ice cream shops do not require a L1 Worker, however they do need a L2 Worker present at all operating times of food service.

Low risk temporary food stands do not need a certified food worker on site.

Certification

Level 1 Food Manager—Local

\$140.00

This course is targeted to food managers and supervisors of kitchen staff and food facilities. It is a locally recognized course in which the certification is valid for five years.

7 hrs. of training + exam

Level 2 Food Worker

\$105.00

This course is targeted to food workers. It is a local course focused on the NYS Sanitary Code. The Certification is valid for three years.

6 hrs. of training + exam

Level 1 Re-Certification— Local

\$100.00

This course is only for those who have already taken Level 1 and need to recertify.

5 hours training + exam

Level 2 Recertification

\$50.00

This course is for those who have already taken Level 2 and need to recertify.
